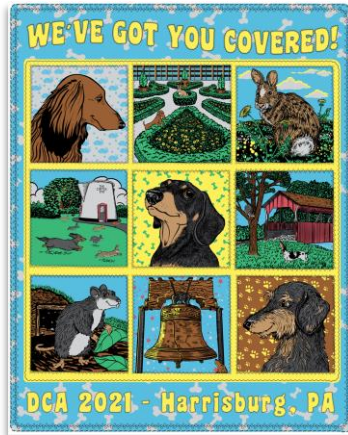

****Please note: Bred By Exhibitor classes will be judged first in each Variety in all 3 specialties****

Open Classes Divided:

Open Miniature (For Wirehaired) - 11 lbs and under and 12 months or older.

Open Miniature, Black and Tan and any other color except Red AOCXR (For Longhaired & Smooth) - 11 lbs and under and 12 months or older.

Open Miniature, Red (For Longhaired & Smooth) - 11 lbs and under and 12 months or older.

Open Standard (For Wirehaired) - Over 11 lbs and 11 lbs. and under if less than 12 months old.

Open Standard, Black and Tan and any other color except Red AOCXR (For Longhaired & Smooth) - Over 11 lbs and 11 lbs. and under if less than 12 months old.

Open Standard, Red (For Longhaired & Smooth) - Over 11 lbs and 11 lbs. and under if less than 12 months old.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries (National Specialty Only):

Winners of these Classes are eligible to compete in Best of Variety-

Veteran Classes: Open to dogs and bitches 7 years and older; neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Competitive Veterans Classes at independent specialties.

Veteran classes divided as follows: 7-under • 9 years • 9-under 11 years • 11 years and older.

Field Trial:* Open to dogs or bitches that have placed in an AKC sanctioned or licensed field trial.

Dual Champion:* Open to dogs and bitches that have earned both an AKC Show Championship as well as an AKC Field Trial Championship.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries (DFABC & MWDC HOST SHOWS as noted):

Winners of these Classes are eligible to compete in Best of Variety

Competitive Veteran Classes: Open to dogs and bitches 7 years and older; neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in **Competitive Veterans Classes** at independent specialties.

Veteran classes divided as follows: 7-under • 9 years • 9-under 11 years • 11 years and older.

Field Trial (DFABC only):* Open to dogs or bitches that have placed in an AKC sanctioned or licensed field trial.

Dual Champion (DFABC only):* Open to dogs and bitches that have earned both an AKC Show Championship as well as an AKC Field Trial Championship.

** neutered dogs and spayed bitches are NOT allowed to compete in these non-regular (FT & DC) classes.*

ADDITIONAL Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

BRACE CLASS (National Specialty Only)

In accordance with AKC rule Ch 11, Sec 8, a neutered dog may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in a Brood Bitch class.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class: For stud dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud dog must be entered in the appropriate Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. Owner of stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based upon their merits. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class: (National Only) Brace Class shall be for two dogs of the same variety and at least one common owner. Dogs do NOT have to be entered in another class at this show. The entry forms must be marked accordingly in the space for Classes as Brace. If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc. Dogs comprising each brace must be named at time of entry

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

Sweepstakes Eligibility: Any purebred dachshund, individually registered with AKC, 6 months and under 18 months of age and entered in a regular class at this show.

Classes for dogs and for bitches, divided by coat variety

Puppy, 6-9 months Puppy, 9-12 months Junior, 12-18 months

Best of Variety and *Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety* (open to first place winner in each class) to be judged separately in each variety.

Best in Sweepstakes and *Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes* will be chosen from the *Sweepstakes Variety* and *Best of Opposite Sex in Variety* winners.

PARADE OF VETERANS (National Specialty Only)

This non-competitive parade is open to any dachshund that is 7 years of age or older and not entered in any other class at the show. **Please submit a short history (150 words or fewer) of your veteran with your entry form. This history, if within the correct number of words, will be included in the catalog and read during the parade. Histories longer than 150 words will not be in the catalog.**

OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIALS

DCA will refund entry fees (less \$10.00) in Obedience & Rally for bitches who come in season after entries close provided a veterinary certificate is presented to the Superintendent **30 minutes prior** to the start of regular judging.

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES (National Specialty Only)

VETERAN: The Veteran Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least seven years old on the date of the trial.

BRACE: The Brace Class will be for two dogs that are eligible under these regulations and capable of performing the **Novice** exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. If more than one Brace is entered, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc. Dogs comprising each brace must be named at time of entry.

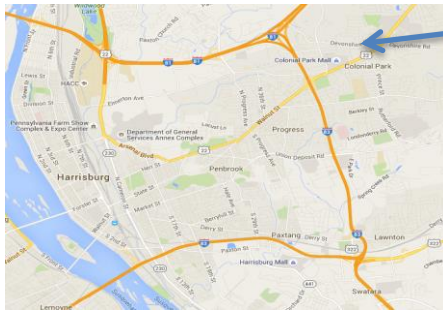

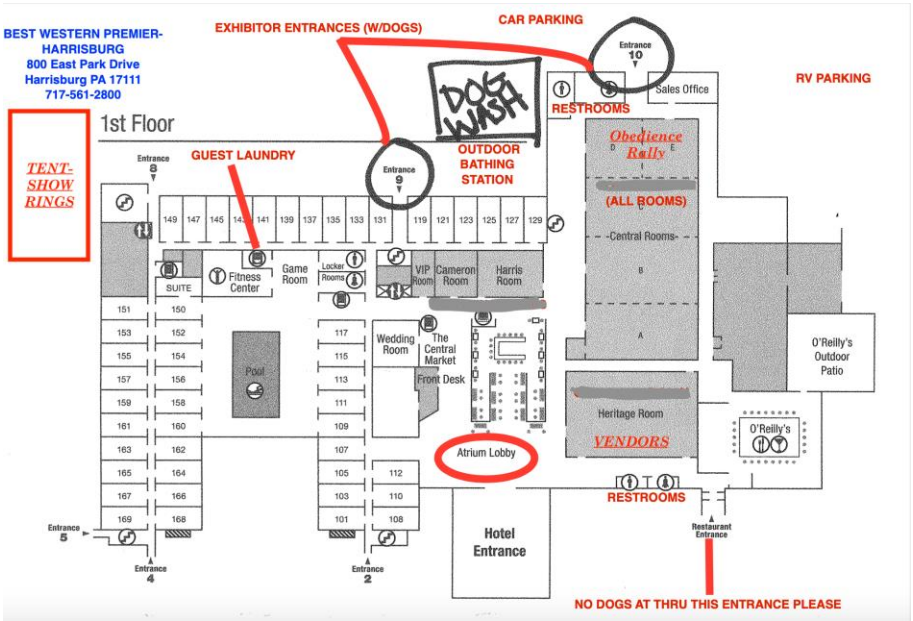

Hotel Dog Show Guidelines

- There will be a maximum of four (4) dogs allowed per room. ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST HAVE CURRENT VACCINATIONS AND OWNERS MUST PRESENT VALIDATION OF RABIES VACCINATIONS IF NECESSARY.
- The guest will be charged a one-time non-refundable dog fee of \$75.00 per stay. This fee applies to all guests with dogs. Fee is fixed and will not change whether guest stays one night or five nights.
- Dogs left unattended in guestrooms must be crated. **Plastic sheeting must be placed under each crate.**
- **Dogs are not allowed on balconies above first floor. This is a significant safety hazard, and violation will incur a bench committee hearing.**
- Housekeeping must be allowed to clean a guestroom at least every two days. Please hang 'Do Not Disturb' sign on door if you do not want housekeeping service that day.
- Owners/exhibitors should bring their own towels for bathing dogs. A daily inventory for missing or damaged towels will be taken. Any necessary charges will be applied to the guest's bill.
- Individual guests will be responsible for any damage to a guestroom or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to, replacement cost for carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed with traditional cleaning methods.
- Dogs are to be leashed at all times when out of the guestroom.
- Dogs will not be allowed in the following public areas: restaurants, lounge, public function space and the respective hallways to the areas listed. Exceptions will be made when functions call for the dogs to be in these areas.
- Extension cords are not allowed to be plugged in to rooms from a vehicle, trailer or camper in the parking lot.
- If the hotel receives excessive barking complaints from a guestroom, guests will be asked to check out immediately.
- The hotel and a member of the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined in this agreement. Any guest not adhering to this agreement will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.
- There will be designated areas that allow exercising of dogs. X-pens placed outside of this designated area will be removed. **Please clean up after your dog in all areas of the property and place waste in designated buckets and/or trash cans.**

Our Programs and Priorities

Hemangiosarcoma (HSA) is an aggressive cancer in dogs and carries a poor prognosis. There are limited therapeutic options for the treatment of HSA, with none currently providing a significant opportunity for long-term survival. Inclusive of the common ER presentation, surgery, diagnostics/staging, and chemotherapy, HSA impacts numerous specialty services throughout a hospital and accordingly the unmet needs are recognized by all parts of the profession.

Through our previous work in hemangiosarcoma ([Canine Hemangiosarcoma Molecular Profiling study](#)) we now have new knowledge in HSA that allows truly innovative trials investigating its diagnosis, prognosis, and treatment. The collective data obtained from these planned studies will provide significant translational benefit for humans affected with a similar cancer, angiosarcoma.

Future Hemangiosarcoma Studies

- **Hemangiosarcoma Liquid Biopsy**
A liquid biopsy in cancer medicine refers to the detection of cancer-specific cellular or subcellular analytes that allow a cancer diagnosis to be made from blood rather than the traditional approach of requiring a tissue biopsy. There is a clear need for this innovation in the diagnosis and management of canine HSA, specifically to differentiate between benign and malignant disease when a dog is diagnosed with a splenic tumor rupture in the ER. There is value in such a test being able to predict prognosis and burden of disease as a reference lab offering. Preliminary analysis of tumor and blood DNA suggest both diagnostic assays may be reasonably developed for canine HSA patients; however, further innovations in device technology are needed to deliver a point of care test result, at this time.
- **Hemangiosarcoma Specialized Test for the Assessment of Molecular Prognosis (STAMP)**
This tissue-based assay is based on our new understanding of Hemangiosarcoma (HSA) derived from the CHAMP study, which has defined this disease in at least four distinct genomic groups. Preliminary data suggests

biologically distinct behaviors for these molecular subtypes and also provides a biological rationale for distinct therapeutic approaches for the subtypes (a focus of the ePUSH study). There is value to clinicians and clients to understand prognostic differences that may exist between patients and to select patient-specific treatment approaches (potentially supported by the ePUSH data). Collectively, the HSA STAMP provides an opportunity to develop a truly novel assay for clinicians managing dogs with this aggressive cancer. Upon scientific validation (proposed now) we predict this assay to be rapidly adopted within the standard of care diagnostic work up of this disease, initially as an integrated assay added to the existing pathology assessment of the tumor. Results of this study will then support the scientific prioritization of gene targets for the planned POC liquid biopsy diagnostic.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.
